The Green Button is a state seal for sustainably produced textiles. It sets binding requirements to protect people and the environment in the production process of textiles. What is special about the Green Button is that, in addition to the product, the company as a whole is always inspected.

As a certification body approved by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), Hohenstein is authorized to test companies and products for compliance with the criteria for awarding the Green Button textile seal.

The special feature of the Green Button:

THE TWO PILLARS OF THE GREEN BUTTON CERTIFICATION LABEL



1. COMPANY AUDIT

The company as a whole is required to demonstrate its social, environmental and human rights responsibility, on the basis of 20 criteria.

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2. PRODUCT AUDIT

Each product is required to comply with 26 social and environmental criteria, covering a wide spectrum from proper wastewater discharge to a ban on forced labour.

As an OEKO-TEX® founding member, we award the MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX® label for textiles that have been tested for harmful substances and produced in an environmentally friendly and socially responsible manner.
